




- · The child must learn to excel for his own sake. Self- study must be an integral feature of the child's education.




From 1971...

#### THE TIME LINE:

Jamnabai Narsee School has developed a rich history in the field of education in its relatively young life.

Founded in 1971 by the Narsee Monjee Educational Trust, staffed by a dedicated team of teacher-facilitators, the school in its fifth decade has established itself as a model of academic excellence and co-curricular cultural experience for all its students.

The school motto 'Vidya Param Balam' - Knowledge is Strength Supreme -has indeed proven to be





the guiding vision statement and the beacon light for all.

Jamnabai Narsee School is a secular co-educational private minority school, managed by the Public Charitable Trust that was established by Sarvashree Chatrabhuj Narsee, Shri Pratap Narsee and Shri Dharamshi Narsee in December 1970. Today, while providing a positive learning environment to our students, the school prepares the students for five curricular options:

The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) Examinations-CISCE, New Delhi - The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) - Cambridge International Examinations (CIE), UK - The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) - MHRD - New Delhi. At the high school level the following are offered: Indian School Certificate (ISC) Examinations - CISCE - New Delhi and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP)-IBO -Geneva.

The comfort of the parent and student with this integral K-12 system that is provided by the school in its fifth decade of growth, assures the community around of a well balanced educational approach unmatched in the city of Mumbai.

#### THE ORIGINS:

On January 17, 1971, Jamnabai Narsee Multipurpose Higher Secondary School was inaugurated by the Narsee Monjee family.

Sarvashree Chatrabhuj Narsee, Shri Pratap Narsee and Shri Dharamshi Narsee decided to start an English medium school to provide broad based education at all stages from K-12. The new Trust so formed was to look after the development and the management of this institution.

In January 1971, the school started functioning under the leadership of the founder Principal, Late Shri Soli Pavri.

This is the first school in the city to provide Gujarati and Marathi in addition to Hindi as languages for the ICSE Examinations.

This is also the first school to offer students a wide range of hobby classes incorporated in the school time-table.

Shri Jairaj Thacker - the Managing Trustee - with Founder Trustee Shri Sureshbhai Oza & Trustees Shri Jayesh D. Thacker, Smt. Urvashi J. Thacker, Smt. Shivangi J. Thacker, Shri Sujay Jairaj and Smt. Minal Thacker - the members on the Board believe that education is a creative process where the efforts of the child, the parent and the educator



unite to create a personality which will face the unknown future with humility, confidence and joy. Coordination of well tested policies by the Board of Trustees has helped to evolve Jamnabai Narsee School into an institution of integrity offering quality education.

As the years roll by, JNS has only one constant - 'CHANGE'.










### PRE-SCHOOL



At Jamnabai Narsee School, the preschool programme (Nursery, Junior and Senior KG classes) provides activities in its curriculum that stimulate the development of social and emotional skills. We help develop the different potential pathways to learning through the child's interest and 'Multiple Intelligences'.

Lessons learnt from free activities allow children to interpret life from personal experiences. Play combines attention and relaxation, purpose with freedom and rules with indepedence. Teaching is interactive and often through storytelling, reading books and muppet and puppet shows.

The atmosphere is one of freedom, play and joy through innovative and energized activities. Organized learning structures intend to exercise the child's senses, limbs, muscles and familiarize him with







the environment. The environment offers education that makes a child joyful and proud in his everyday achievements.











### PRIMARY SCHOOL

## MIDDLE & SECONDARY SCHOOL





In the primary classes (Std. I to IV) we believe 'Direct Experience' is the basis for all learning. Spontaneous activities of a child provide the natural condition for the growth and acquisition of knowledge. 'The learning by doing approach' based on the child's needs and interests paves way for the project method of teaching. The curriculum in the primary school is organized according to the fourfold interests of the child – in conversation, inquiry, construction and artistic expression.

The curriculum helps develop critical discrimination and reasoning ability in a child. The focus will be on the child's counting and reckoning skills which lead to the development of primary mathematics. Emphasis will be laid on the importance of sound, form and number, providing the child with the opportunity to learn the foundational aspects of all subjects.



All the qualities of an intelligent democratic citizen like initiative, independence and resourcefulness will be developed in every child. Importance will be given to observation; thus preparing the way for the development of a scientific mind.

The child is introduced to the world of reality, spontaneously and joyfully through periodic field trips to Nature Parks, Conservation Centres and eco-friendly destinations which help develop skills and values of love, concern and preservation of the flora, fauna and natural resources. Outbound education starts from Class III. Art, Craft, Yoga, Physical Education, Dance and Music will form an integral part of the curriculum in primary education. Emphasis is on co-operation and not on competition.









Education in the Secondary school aims at stimulating the spiritual, intellectual, emotional and physical faculties of the child. Facts of Social Studies and Sciences are studied first-hand from direct sources as far as possible. An interdisciplinary approach is adopted, which helps present the subjects in an integrated manner.

The pupils of grades 9 and 10 are prepared for the ICSE and the pupils of grade 11 and 12 for the ISC Examinations conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi.

We lay stress not only on academic excellence but also on the holistic development, preparing every pupil passing through our portals to face the outside world with confidence and integrity. While rigorous academics remains our hallmark with regular class tests, online assignments and remedial classes. due importance is also given to the mental and emotional wellbeing of our students through initiatives like the mentor-mentee system. The school also believes in honing the leadership qualities of the student community, resulting in the creation of such ventures as the student led monthly school newsletter, JeNerationS and the Ecotopia Club which aims at a sustainable and responsible use of resources.

As a part of EUMIND International Exchange Programme, our students work in close collaboration with their European counterparts, an initiative aimed at creating truly global citizens.

A comprehensive programme of Socially Useful Productive Work



(SUPW) and Community Service reaches out to the less privileged in our society through reputed NGOs.
